

A Message from Pastor Robin



Dear Beloved People of God,

We trek slowly through the darkness of Holy Week to come into the wondrous light and love of the resurrection. This signals a new day, for all who had lived under the curse of death are offered the gift of life! We go through seasons of our own life, some dark and difficult and some full of joy and light! As we journey toward this Easter, I am reflecting and rejoicing.

Last August, marked Rob's 10th year at St. Andrews. I am still amazed at the leap of faith he took to move his family and start ministry here, having no idea who the pastor would end up being. Rob has a heart for Christ, and it is a blessing to see this more and more as he follows the Spirit in ever expanding ministry opportunities. He continues to pour the love of God into our children and youth, while expanding that into the neighborhood and community with Easter Egg Hunts and Spark Park Days, as well as working with the Lebanon Coalition to End Homelessness. Rob is one of those people in ministry who makes the people around him better, lifts up their ideas and weaves in his own. In this last year, he has moved into the Ordination Process for the Presbyterian Church.

2025 marks 15 years Carole and Lisa have led us in worship and in so much wonderful music. They are a delight to work with and have grounded our music and worship through so many transitions. In 2019 they led the choir to Carnegie Hall and then found themselves needing to rebuild a choir after the pandemic. With perseverance they have built and re-built the Chancel Choir and the Bells of St. Andrews! Carole has revived our Concert Series expanding the love of music we have here at St. Andrews into our community. Their work blesses us and glorifies God, every week.

April 30th will be the 10th anniversary since I was installed here at St. Andrews. The words God gave me in 2015 were 'Trust the Journey.' As a congregation you hired a single pastor, with big gaps in experience. You offered space to grow, an abundance of grace, and so kindly offered your wisdom and advice. You have been so amazingly faithful, and my life shifted, and you welcomed Troy, then Reilly and we truly found out what support was when Dashiell was born. I am beyond grateful that you offered me maternity leave, when it was not required and have cared for me and my family, as I sought to care for you, all of God's beloved people here at St. Andrews.

The night I was installed the sanctuary was filled with music and flowers fresh cut from a garden. Pastors from the community graciously made time to come and worship with us. And our Emeritus Pastor Dick Cassel offered his blessing with a card and a bottle of scotch right in the middle of my desk. The benediction was the one thing I prepared for the installation service. It was all written out, and yet when the moment came completely different words spilled out of my mouth: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!" We are on an amazing journey together; it is far from over. I am still living into those words I was given so long ago, Trust the Journey.

The last few years had brought a few staff changes and have formed a staff that fits St. Andrews so well. As Cliffy retired, it was a relief to have Mary Lynne step in. She is more than capable and helps all of us stay organized. She can finish almost any sentence with a song. She laughs easily, will work on anything that is needed and can get a whole day's worth of work done, while I am trying to find the right songs for Sunday. Speaking of the right songs, it is not simple to bring together different styles of music in worship. Johnathan has been the perfect fit for us. He leads us in new songs and songs that stay in our hearts and our minds. He stepped into the congregation right as we were upgrading the Tech for worship and we quickly discovered how much we needed him. He is willing and helpful, and I am so grateful he is here at St. Andrews. Johnathan also is great at bringing laughter into our staff meetings. Lew quietly learned our streaming system and seamlessly stepped in when we needed it. He truly is a lifelong learner and continues to learn and improve our media in worship. Any problem that arises, Lew rises up to the challenge, researching and working on the problem, so that online worship is ready for all who worship right where they are. Lew continues to use media to connect us to God, through online prayer requests, to one another with the online friendship register and offering the peace of Christ, in all of our languages. As a congregation you have formed a staff that works so well with the congregation and continually seeks to follow Christ.

It has been a decade of ups and downs, and yet as a congregation you have been so faithful. You have continued to look toward God, you have courageously been open to what is next and to all who the Spirit brings. You have continued to support and encourage your staff, and it is time to celebrate! A celebration is being planned for May 4th to honor Carole and Lisa's 15 years, as well as Rob's 10 years, and my own. May there be many more years to serve Christ together, right here at St. Andrews. I am beyond grateful to serve as your pastor and to continue of this wondrous journey of faith with you. Eastertide is the perfect time to celebrate together and to celebrate the life that God continues to give to us as a congregation.

As we move into this season of Eastertide, may we remember and marvel at the good news. And may we celebrate together! At the installation service a decade ago, the Rev. Larry Van Hies offered us a charge, "The mission field is just past your front doors."

How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news! May we go into this season sharing the good news of Christ who is alive and who brings love and grace and LIFE! We need this. Our neighbors need this. Our world needs this.




Holy Week

Together we go through the highs and lows.


We praise Jesus in the Triumphal Entry!


Summer Sharing Adventure
