Principally Harps offers audiences a unique opportunity to see and hear concert grand harps on center stage, as opposed to "hidden" among the instruments in an orchestra.

Mindy Cutcher is principal harpist with the Philadelphia Ballet Orchestra and has appeared with the Baltimore, Delaware, and St. Louis Symphonies. She has also performed in Japan and on The Tonight Show.

Janet Witman is principal harpist with the Kennett Symphony and has been a soloist with the Allentown, Kennett, Hilton Head, and Savannah Symphonies.

Both musicians studied under the legendary harp teacher, Alice Chalifoux, and are graduates of the Oberlin Conservatory and Curtis Institute of Music.
