Lent invites us to slow down, listen more closely to God, and intentionally grow in faith through prayer, scripture study, and community. This year the Christian Education Committee is pleased to offer the following study opportunities for us as we walk through the Lenten season. Please join one or all as you feel led.

WEBS: Beginning Wednesday February 25th at 6:30 pm we will begin a six-week study based on the book "Bread and Broth" by Cynthia E. Cowen. Each week we will share a simple meal of soup and bread while reflecting on scripture and the lives of key biblical figures as we journey toward Easter together.
